Organizational Context

The Summer Work Programme

The UNSSC is now accepting applications from undergraduate/graduate students for the Summer Work Programme. The objective of the programme is to provide the undergraduate/graduate students with exposure to the administrative and programmatic work of the UNSSC and of international organizations in general. During the programme period, students will apply their skills in supporting the activities of UNSSC. They will also gain understanding of the UN's work and the development of learning programmes for UN personnel. The students will be mentored by professional UNSSC personnel and will gain knowledge of the administrative and programmatic work of the Staff College.

Students will be exposed to the work of the Staff College in the following areas:

- Administrative operations
- Learning and training activities
- Research and Innovation

Required Skills and Experience

Education: applicants must be enrolled in an internationally recognized Bachelor's or Master's programme.

Experience: previous work experience is not required.

Language: excellent communication skills (written and oral) in English are required.

Other skills and competencies

- High motivation to learn
- Ability to work effectively as part of a team.
- Ability to work in a multicultural, multi-ethnic environment and to maintain effective working relations with people of different national and cultural backgrounds.

- An up-to-date curriculum vitae (resume);
- A brief motivation letter;
- Proof of university enrolment.
