The UN Summer Academy provides an exclusive opportunity for dialogue with professionals and thought leaders who are currently working towards the implementation of the 2030 Agenda and the Paris Agreement. Since 2012, the UN Summer Academy has been a flagship programme of the UN System Staff College and it prides itself in offering executive education, learning and knowledge exchange since its inception.

As the world community prepares for the first SDG Summit in September 2019 under the auspices of the UN General Assembly, the eighth edition of the UN Summer Academy will focus on reviewing progress made in view of the implementation of the 2030 Agenda thus far. It will also provide conceptual background knowledge about the Sustainable Development Goals, including the Paris Agreement under the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change.

The participants of the UN Summer Academy will include staff from across the United Nations System, government officials of various countries, civil society and private sector representatives.
